#### Who can nominate?

Any person who is an Australian Citizen over the age of 18 years who is an elector of the district and is not disqualified under the *Local Government Act 1995* may nominate for council.

## When to nominate

Nominations open on 2 September 2021 and close at 4.00pm sharp on 9 September 2021.

## Where to nominate

Shire of Sandstone Hack Street Sandstone WA 6639

Nominations must be on a prescribed form that is available from the council office. An \$80 nomination deposit is required as well as a profile of the candidate consisting of no more than 150 words. You can include a recent passport sized photo of the candidate's head or head and shoulders if you wish.

All candidates are now required to undergo a Local Government Candidate Induction before nominating, which can be done online at <a href="https://www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au/council-elections/local-government-candidate-induction">www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au/council-elections/local-government-candidate-induction</a>. If you are unable to personally attend to nominate, an authorised agent can do this on your behalf.
